

Order No. 2009 of 12th of February 2001
on the approval of the Norms for licensing experts

The Minister of Culture and Religious Affaires,

On the basis of the stipulations of Governmental Decision no. 28/2001 regarding the organization and functioning of the Ministry of Culture and Religious Affaires and of the art. 77 paragraph (2) of Law no 182/2000 regarding the protection of the movable national cultural heritage,

passes the following order:

The norms for licensing experts, included in the appendix of the present order, are approved.

APPENDIX:

Order No. 2009 of 12th of February 2001 on the approval of the Norms for licensing experts

(at the 6th of March 2001 the bill was approved by Decree 2009/2001)

Art. 1.

(1) In order to obtain the expert license, the applicants must gather at least 40 points in conformity with the synopsis of the following criteria.

1. Specialised studies (criterion 10 points compulsory)
2. Experience in the field:
 - 0-15 years: 5 points
 - 15-20 years: 10 points
 - over 20 years: 15 points
3. Specialization courses and/or stages:
 - refresher courses organised by the Minister of Culture/Minister of Education (3 points for each certificate)
 - specialization stages abroad (5-20 points for each certificate, depending on the length and the complexity of the stage)
4. Specialised scientific stages and titles:
 - MA: 3 points
 - PhD student: 5 points
 - doctor: 10 points
5. Scientific stages and titles:
 - MA: 3 points
 - PhD student: 5 points
 - doctor: 10 points
6. Specialised scientific papers:
 - scientific catalogue: 3-10 points (for each catalogue)
 - studies and articles published in specialised magazines (3 points for each article)
 - scientific book published as sole author: 10-15 points
 - scientific book - joint author: 5 points (for each book)
7. Practical experience in the field:
 - permanent expositions: 10 points

- temporary expositions: 2-4 points (for each exposition)
 - field research: 3-5 points (for each campaign)
8. The experts thus licensed will be added to the Experts' Resister.

Art. 2

(1) The application file will be delivered at the Museums, Collections and Visual Arts Department from the Ministry of Culture and will enclose the following documents:

- a) application form;
- b) resume;
- c) copies of study certificates;
- d) copies of the employment record book;
- e) criminal record;
- f) two recommendation letters from institutions specialised in the field and/or highly experienced specialists;
- g) the list of the titles, publishing house and the year of issue.

(2) The Museums, Collections and Visual Arts Department will verify all the documents enclosed in the file. If the file is not complete, it will solicit in writing, within 5 days, that the file is completed; within 10 days, the candidate will add the necessary documents to the file.

Art. 3

(1) The Museums, Collections and Visual Arts Department will forward the application file to the National Commission of Museums and Collections.

(2) After having examined the file and interviewing the candidates, the National Commission of Museums and Collections licenses the experts.

Art. 4

(1) A certificate as in the enclosed appendix will be issued for the successful applicants.

(2) The applicants whose files were rejected by the National Commission of Museums and Collections may appeal for re-evaluation, in writing, 30 days after acknowledging the result.

(3) The appeal will be delivered in writing at the Museums, Collections and Visual Arts Department and it will be examined within 15 days by a commission appointed by the minister of culture and religious affaires; if the applicant is not satisfied by the result of the re-evaluation, he/she may appeal to the administrative court, in conformity with the law.

Art. 5

Only the specialists listed in the Experts' Register are qualified to expertise for the courts of law, notaries public, at their request.
